cientable repair and condition unto the said Mahlon Janney
hereabouts. It witnesseth whereof his said party have hereunto
interchangably set their hands and seals the day month and year
first above written.

the decease of any two of the lives above mentioned the said Francis
Sanders his heirs executors administrators or assigns may have the
liberty to nominate one more life additional to this demise pay
forty three shillings and nine pence for renewing such life
